

WHAT IS EDUPUNK?

Edupunk is an educational philosophy and approach that began as a backlash against the traditional education system. The term was first used by teacher Jim Groom in 2008. Edupunk emphasizes a more creative and autonomous approach to education by combining the DIY (Do It Yourself) spirit with technology.

THE BASIC ELEMENTS OF EDUPUNK EDUCATION I. DIY

• Autonomous learning: We set our own learning goals, find the materials we need, learn & study.

• Creative Approaches: We move beyond traditional textbooks and teaching methods and creatively solve problems and undertake projects.

2. USE OF TECHNOLOGY

- Open Source Tools: Take advantage of freely and low cost available online courses, videos, tutorials & more.
- Digital platforms: Share and discuss our learnings through blogs, forums, social media, etc.
- Internet Resources: Learn through a variety of online resources and digital tools.

3. PROJECT-BASED LEARNING

- Real-World Projects: We apply and practice what we learn through real-world projects.
- Problem Solving: Develop creativity and problemsolving skills through projects.

4. COLLABORATIVE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

- Group activities: Provides opportunities for us to share our knowledge and skills and collaborate with each other.
- Community Learning: We develop collaboration and networking skills through learning communities.

5. CREATIVITY AND AUTONOMY

- Individualized Learning Paths: We learn according to our interests and needs.
- Independent Thinking: We think and learn independently.

6. CRITICAL THINKING

- Develop critical thinking: We develop the ability to view problems from multiple perspectives and think critically.
- Self-assessment: We are able to assess and improve our own learning.

EDUPUNK FOCUSES ON ENABLING US TO HAVE A BETTER LEARNING EXPERIENCE AND DEVELOP THE ABILITY TO SOLVE PROBLEMS AUTONOMOUSLY AND CREATIVELY.

The most important elements in edupunk education are autonomy and creativity.

AUTONOMY

- Self-directed learning: Allow students to set their own learning goals and choose their own learning methods and materials. This allows students to take responsibility for their learning and become self-motivated.
- Independent Thinking: Helps students develop the ability to think independently and solve problems.


CREATIVITY

- Creative Approaches: We move beyond traditional teaching methods and encourage students to creatively solve problems and learn in their own way.
- Project-based learning: Allows students to be creative and apply what they learn to real-world situations through real-world projects.

Edupunk focuses on providing an environment where we can learn freely and creatively without being confined to a set framework. We learn and teach according to our interests and needs and develop problem-solving and critical thinking skills.


